

3 Irons Horse & Cattle Co. Facility Rules

1. Facility is not open to the general public-only clients; therefore, our barn hours are BY APPOINTMENT ONLY.
2. Do not tie horses to paddock/pasture fencing, H braces, or gates. Only tie horses in designated areas in the arena or barn.
3. Our arena and round pen are constructed out of creosote quarter rounds-creosote can cause skin irritation, and will stain clothing, please refrain from rubbing, or touching the walls of the arena and round pen for your own safety.
4. If your horse is in training with us please provide appropriate notice of a visit, we do have a schedule. Two days in advance, at least, is appreciated. If you want to schedule a lesson, and view your horse working in training, please make this clear so we can schedule an appropriate amount of time for both activities.
5. Release and Liability waivers, Boarding/Training Contracts must be completed and signed prior to riding/horse drop off.
6. No unauthorized persons shall enter barn, arena, or horse pastures
7. Do not handle horses other than your own, unless granted permission through barn management
8. Do not leave horses unsupervised
9. Clean up manure after your horse immediately
10. Do not leave halters and other equipment on ground
11. All jumping riders must wear helmets
12. All riders under 18 must wear helmets
13. No smoking on the property
14. Keep gates closed and latched.
15. Drive slowly and cautiously in driveways and parking areas. Max. speed 5mph
16. Ride in designated areas only

17. When grounds are wet, please stay on the sand walkways.

18. Use arena etiquette while riding in designated areas (pass on inside, left hand to left hand, jumping riders have right-of-way, etc)

19. No horseplay in the barn or arena

20. ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOL, OR DRUGS allowed on property.
